Subject: - Selection for the post of Presiding Officer in Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT), Mumbai - Reg.

Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT) is a statutory body established under the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992 to hear and dispose of appeals against orders passed by the Securities and Exchange Board of India, the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) constituted under the PFRDA Act, 2013, Insurance Regulatory Development Authority of India (IRDAI) constituted under the Insurance Act, 1938, the General Insurance Business (Nationalization) Act, 1972 and the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority Act, 1999 and the Rules and Regulations framed thereunder. SAT is situated at Mumbai, and the Presiding Officer, upon selection, will be posted at Mumbai.

- 2. Applications are being invited for one post of Presiding Officer, SAT, Mumbai.
- 3. The qualifications, eligibility, salary and other terms and conditions of the appointment of a candidate for the post of Presiding Officer will be governed by the provisions of the Tribunals (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2021. Select provisions are given below:
- (A) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as the Presiding Officer of the Securities Appellate Tribunal, unless he, —
- (i) has attained the age of fifty years on or before 15th September 2023<last date of receipt of applications>;
- (ii) is, or has been, a Judge of the Supreme Court or a Chief Justice of a High Court.
- (B) A Member or Part time Member of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Board) or the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority or the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority, or any person at senior management level equivalent to Executive Director in the Board or in such Authorities, shall not be appointed as the Presiding Officer of the Securities Appellate Tribunal, during his service or tenure as such with the Board or with such Authorities, as the case may be, or within two years from the date on which he ceases to hold office as such in the Board or in such Authorities.

- (C) The Presiding Officer of the Securities Appellate Tribunal shall be a person who does not have any financial or other interests as are likely to prejudicially affect their functions as such Member.
- 3.1 The Presiding Officer shall be paid a salary of Rs. Two lakh fifty thousand (fixed) per month. In case the person appointed as Presiding Officer is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension drawn by him.
- 3.2 The appointment of the Presiding Officer shall be done after issuance of a Certificate of Medical Fitness by an authority specified by the Central Government in this behalf.
- 4. The Search-Cum-Selection Committee constituted under the Tribunal Reforms Act 2021 for recommending names for appointment to the said post shall scrutinize the applications with respect to suitability of application for the post by giving due weightage to qualification and experience of candidates and shortlist candidates for conducting personal interaction. The final selection will be done on the basis of overall evaluation of candidates done by the Committee based on the qualification, experience and personal interaction.
- 5. Applications of eligible and willing officers are requested through proper channel (wherever applicable) and must be accompanied with bio-data in the proforma at Annexure-I.
