G20 Domestic Side Events on Cyber Security by Reserve Bank of India at Bengaluru on February 20, 2023

In the build-up to the G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors (FMCBG) meeting and the G20 Finance and Central Banks Deputies (FCBD) meeting, two domestic events related to Cyber Security were organised by RBI at Bengaluru on February 20, 2023. The two events were:

Event 1: Cyber Security – Challenges and Strategies (for Technical Experts)

Event 2: Cyber Security - The Present-Day Need (for Common Public)

- 2. Event 1 started in the morning with keynote address by Executive Director RBI, followed by two Panel discussions. One Panel discussed on cyber security challenges faced by banks and strategies to mitigate them. It had experts representing Government of India, RBI, Commercial Banks, Academia, and Practitioners. The other Panel discussion comprised experts from SEBI and other capital market players and deliberated on cyber security in the capital market and ways for suitable risk mitigation. Event 1 had around 175 participants comprising officials from RBI, SEBI, IRDAI, PFRDA, Commercial Banks, NBFCs, Urban Co-operative Banks, State Government officials and Police Officials from Cyber Cell.
- 3. Event 2 started in the afternoon with a session from a banker on 'Next Gen Banking', followed by a session on 'Cyber Frauds in Digital Banking Do's and Don'ts' by RBI officials. These sessions covered the future changes foreseen in the banking industry, especially on the digital front, and created awareness about prevention of cyber frauds. Event 2 had around 250 participants representing RBI, members of public, and college students.
