INTRODUCTION

1. At present, Ministry of Finance has the following six Departments:

1. Department of Economic Affairs
2. Department of Expenditure
3. Department of Revenue
4. Department of Financial Services
5. Department of Investment and Public Asset Management
6. Department of Public Enterprises

2. The Ministry of Finance was re-organized in the year 1949 in two Departments:

- (a) Department of Revenue and Expenditure; and
- (b) Department of Economic Affairs.

In 1956, two separate Departments viz. Department of Revenue and Department of Expenditure were created.

Ministry of Disinvestment which was created in December 1999 was brought under Ministry of Finance as 'Department of Disinvestment' in May 2004. The Department of Disinvestment was renamed Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) w.e.f. from 14th April, 2016.

On 28th June, 2007, a new Department of Financial Services was created by carving the Banking and Insurance Division out of the Department of Economic Affairs.

On 06th July, 2021 Department of Public Enterprises, which was earlier under Ministry of Heavy Industries, was made a part of Ministry of Finance.

3. Vision:

Promote faster, equitable and sustainable growth of Indian economy.

4. Mission:

To formulate policies and advice for maintaining sound public finances through sustainable, equitable and efficient use of the nation's economic resources, promoting conditions that accelerate sustainable economic growth through developing sound economic policies and preparing for future economic challenges and opportunities; as well as leading India's bilateral and multilateral economic and financial engagements.

5. Functions:

1. Preparation and presentation of the Union Budget; as well as Budgets for the State Governments under President's Rule and Union Territory Administrations.
2. Formulation and overseeing the economic policies and programmes of the Government having a bearing on domestic and international aspects of economic management including fiscal and monetary policy, public debt management, prices, credit and investment regulations. Borrowings, lending and Ways and Means of the Union Government.

3. Responsible for currency and coins of various denominations.
4. Management of external financing (loans, grants and technical cooperation) from bilateral and multilateral entities, including representing India on the multilateral development banks, contracting of loans (for the GoI, State/UT Governments and other Government entities), repayments, maintenance of accounts, etc.
5. Strengthening external relations (bilateral and multilateral ties) through Finance Tracks of G20, BRICS, SAARC and other multilateral forum such as ASEAN, BIMSTEC, SCO, etc. as well as economic and financial dialogues with key countries.
6. Regulation and policies of Financial Markets, including stock exchanges
7. Matters relating to financial stability, including Financial Stability and Development Council (FSDC), crypto assets, etc.
8. Matters relating to India's inward and outward investments, including National Investment and Infrastructure Fund, Foreign Venture Capital Investment, Alternative Investment Funds, etc.
9. Matters relating to infrastructure policy, including infrastructure financing, capacity building and operations of infrastructure debt funds, Real Estates Investment Trusts (REITs) and Infrastructure Investment Trusts (InvITs), municipal bonds, etc.
10. Matters relating to digital economy, including FinTech
11. Indian Economic Service cadre management


