The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 29th March, 2018, and is hereby published for general information:—

## THE APPROPRIATION (No. 2) ACT, 2018

No. 14 of 2018

[29th March, 2018.]

An Act to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of the financial year 2018-19.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2018.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Ninety-four lakh sixty-one thousand five hundred twenty-four crore and eight lakh rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2018-19 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
- 4. References to Ministries or Departments in the Schedule are to such Ministries or Departments as existing immediately before the 13th September, 2017 and shall, on or after that date, be construed as references to the appropriate Ministries or Departments as reconstituted from time to time.
