DUE-DATE FOR E-FILING RETURNS OF INCOME FOR ASSESSMENT YEAR 2015-16 EXTENDED UP TO 7<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2015 IN RESPECT OF ALL TAXPAYERS WHO WERE REQUIRED TO E-FILE THEIR RETURNS OF INCOME BY 31<sup>ST</sup> AUGUST 2015

The Government has received various representations that tax payers have faced difficulties in E-filing of returns across the country due to slowing down of certain e-services on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015.

Considering these representations, the Central Board Direct Taxes (CBDT) has extended the 'due-date' for E-filing returns of income from 31st August 2015 to 7<sup>th</sup> September 2015 in respect of all taxpayers who were required to E-file their returns of income by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2015.

Earlier, the 'due-date' for filing of Income Tax return for Assessment Year 2015-16 was extended till 31st August, 2015 in case of those taxpayers who were required to file their tax return by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2015.
