**EXCHANGE RATE OF FOREIGN CURRENCY RELATING TO IMPORTED AND
EXPORT GOODS NOTIFIED**

New Delhi, April 16, 2015
Chaitra 26, 1937(SAKA)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 of the Customs Act, 1962 (52 of 1962), and in super session of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) No.35/2015-CUSTOMS (N.T.), dated the 1st April, 2015 *vide* number S.O.916 (E), dated the 1st April, 2015, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such super session, the Central Board of Excise and Customs (CBEC) hereby determines that the rate of exchange of conversion of each of the foreign currency specified in column (2) of each of Schedule I and Schedule II annexed hereto into Indian currency or *vice versa* shall, with effect from 17th April, 2015 be the rate mentioned against it in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof, for the purpose of the said section, relating to imported and export goods.
